VILLAGE OF BJORKDALE

BYLAW NO. 5-10

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE NUMBERING OF HOUSES AND OTHER BUILDINGS.

The Council of the Village of Bjorkdale in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw shall be referred to as the "Civic Addressing Bylaw.
- 2. Forest Avenue shall constitute the base line for numbering along all streets running north and south and Hara Avenue shall constitute the base line for numbering along all streets east and west.
- 3. A uniform system of numbering houses and other buildings is hereby established and is shown on the attached map identified as Schedule "A", appended hereto and forming a part of this bylaw.
- 4. Each house or building shall bear the number assigned to the frontage on which the front entrance is situated.
- 5. Notwithstanding section 4 of this bylaw, upon request of the owner of a property situated on a corner, the number assigned may be specific to the frontage.
- 6. In case a house or building is occupied by more than one family dwelling unit or business, each separate front entrance of said house or building shall bear the same number extended with a letter of the alphabet beginning with the letter "A" and proceeding with as many as are required.
- 7. Numerals indicating the official number of each house or building or each front entrance shall be posted in a manner as to be visible from the street on which the property is located.
- 8. The Administrator shall be responsible for maintaining the numbering system and shall keep a record of all numbers assigned under this bylaw.
- 9. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and shall upon conviction be liable as per the General Penalty Bylaw.

READ THREE TIMES by unanimous vote, and passed by the Council of the Village of Bjorkdale at Bjorkdale, Saskatchewan on the 4th day of May, 2010.
