Chase the Ace Rules

- 1. Tickets are \$5 each
- 2. Winner gets 20% of the weeks' sales
- 3. 30% gets added to the jackpot until the ACE OF SPADES is drawn
- 4. 50% goes to the Bjorkdale Curling Club
- 5. There are no restrictions to purchasing other than you must be in Saskatchewan when you purchase the ticket and you must be present at time of draw to collect prize.
- 6. Ticket sales are restricted to those 19 years of age and older.
- 7. A maximum of **20,000 tickets** may be sold, with a total prize value of **\$50,000**.
- 8. A standard deck of cards will be used.
- Tickets will be sold at: Bjorkdale Valley Inn.
- 10. Weekly ticket draw takes place every **Friday** from January 20th April 28th, 2023 at Bjorkdale Valley Inn, Hara Avenue, Bjorkdale at **8:30 p.m**
- 11. Tickets can be purchased up to one hour prior to the draw on Fridays at Bjorkdale Valley Inn.
- 12. Holder of the weekly wining ticket must be present to claim prize. The weekly winning ticket number will be called up to five times in 15 minutes. If no one comes forward with the winning ticket after 15 minutes, that ticket is disqualified and another draw will be made.
- 13. Distribution of weekly ticket sales:
 - a. 20% will be awarded to the winning ticket holder
 - b. 30% will be added to the growing jackpot.
 - c.50% will go the Bjorkdale Curling Club Fundraising Account.
- 14. Previous to draw the deck will be shown to contain the Ace of Spades, then shuffled previous to draw by selected "winner" for that week.
- 15. Weekly draw winner gets a chance to win 20% of the weekly sales by cutting the standard deck of cards. If the Ace of Spades in chosen from the

deck of cards, the winner gets the jackpot, which includes the 30% of ticket sales for that week and any carry-forward of previous week jackpot. If the Ace of Spades is not drawn, the selected card is removed from the deck and the 30% goes into the prize pot for the next week's draw.

- 16. At the end of each week's "cut the deck" segment, the rest of the deck will be displayed to show that the Ace of Spades is still in in the deck.
- 17. The remaining cards from standard deck, shall be sealed in an envelope by the Bjorkdale Curling Club members in charge of the draw.
- 18. Contest continues with the same standard deck of cards until the Ace of Spades is drawn.
- 19. Once the Ace is drawn, a new contest begins. The Jackpot resets to zero, and a new deck of cards will be used.
- 20. Only tickets sold during the current week are eligible for that week's draw. All previous tickets sold will be removed at the conclusion of each weekly draw.
- 21. No limit on the number of tickets that can be purchased for a draw. Exception to this rule will be the final draw on April 28th, 2023 where tickets are limited to 10 tickets per person.
- 22. No refunds will be allowed for any tickets purchased.
- 23. No receipts will be given for any tickets purchased.
- 24. If the winning ticket has more than one name on it, the prize will be awarded to the first person's name on the ticket. It is the responsibility of the Ticket Holder to distribute the winnings.
- 25. The Bjorkdale Curling Club members, all volunteers and the immediate family ARE allowed to purchase tickets.
- 26. Beginning on Friday, January 20th, 2023, the raffle will continue until final draw Friday, April 28th, 2023.
- 27. Total ticket sales for the duration of the lottery shall not exceed 20,000 in number. In the event that all tickets are sold before April 28th, 2023 date, the draw will take place the Friday that the final ticket is sold, with the Winning Ticket Holder receiving 20% of the weekly sales and will be given a chance to cut the deck of cards of the Ace of Spades. IF the ticket holder does not cut the

Ace of Spades, they will keep the **20% of the weekly sales**, with the remaining 30% to be added to the Jackpot, and another ticket will be drawn. Tickets will continue to be drawn, until a ticket holder cuts the Ace of Spades from the deck of cards, who will then receive the Jackpot total that has accumulated to that time, bringing this Chase the Ace event to it's conclusion. The person who cuts the Ace of Spades will only be entitled to the 30% portion, or the "Jackpot".

- 28. Depending on the value of the prize pot, the winner may be required to come to the **Cornerstone Credit Union in Tisdale with ID** to claim winnings in form of a cheque.
- 29. Winner's cheques will be ready within 3 business days.
